Kyle's Crusaders hits \$100k milestone in fundraising

After the loss of their 16-year-old son, Kyle, to acute myeloid leukemia in 2015, the Addington family set out to fulfill Kyle's wish for a cure for childhood cancer. They created Kyle's Crusaders and host an annual fundraising walk to honor Kyle's memory and raise awareness and funds for pediatric cancer research. With their fourth annual walk this October, Kyle's Crusaders reached a milestone of \$100,000 raised for research.
